Free developmental and autism screenings offered

OKLAHOMA CITY – A program offering free developmental and autism screenings for children ages 0 to 6 is being offered this month through a partnership between Rainbow Fleet and the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center.

The free screenings will test a child's development in language, cognitive, gross motor, fine motor, personal and social areas. Autism screenings are also available.

The screening will be held Nov. 18 at Rainbow Fleet, 3024 Paseo. Call (405) 521-1426 to schedule an appointment.

Child development specialists, speech-language pathologists and behavioral health specialists will conduct the screenings. A parent or legal quardian must accompany the child during the screening process.

"Any parent or guardian concerned with how a child is progressing is encouraged to schedule an appointment," said Carrie Williams, Rainbow Fleet executive director. "Specialists will be on hand to discuss the tests and provide information on available services and resources."
